



Space and Equipment Review for Human Stem Cell Research

All applicants who propose to use any stem cells in their research are required to complete a copy of the Human Stem Cell Research Supplement. If the applicant intends to use Non-Registry hESC lines, the form Request for Equipment Approval must also be completed.

Both forms should be submitted to the Office of the Associate Vice Chancellor for Research, c/o Irene Anicetti, box 0407, fax 415-476-2721. The UCSF Compliance Coordinator is responsible to track and monitor the space and equipment review process and notify the Principal Investigator when the approval is complete. No funding will be available until this review process is complete.
